4 Interpreter Booth



Each person whom wishes to speak needs only to push the microphone button. Each person who wishes to listen to interpretation may connect their headset to one of the dual channel units and tune to language of their preference.

Light-ring will light up to indicate mic is ready to use. All microphones branch out from CCU Unit.

This configuration allows for a dedicated channel for each language.

The system is designed to work as follows:

- 1 DCN Wireless Microphone Discussion System is setup to be used as 1 microphone per two seats. The microphones use DCN Wireless Access Point (WAP) links the central control unit (WCCU) and the wireless discussion units.
- 2 iDesks provide each interpreter with a direct feed of all participant microphones to adequately monitor discussion and provide the highest quality interpretation.
- 3 DCN CCU Unit uses "Floor In" to connect to any PA system, mixer, phone system, or wireless microphone.
- G Booth is positioned in rear of room in order to provide the interpreters the best view of presenters and any video projection. Interpreters are seated in the ISO booth to allow for better concentration and to not disturb attendees seated nearby.
